- Key Skills - Application of Number Level 2 & Communication Level 2

Mandatory Units (4)

- Promote effective communication for & about individuals
- Reflect & develop your practice
- Promote, monitor & maintain, health, safety & security in the workplace
- Promote choice, well-being & the protection of all individuals

Optional Units (4)

Candidates at level 3 must undertake the 4 core units (one of which is contextualised to the Adults Pathway) plus 4 optional units which depend on the candidates area of specialisation.

Course Delivery:

An assessor will visit the candidate at their workplace at least once every three weeks for approximately two hours. In addition to this, they will be set approximately 4 hours worth of work to be complete before the next meeting.

The Technical Certificate at level 3 consists of 4 units.

- Reflecting on and developing own practice in a health and social care role.
- Promoting effective communication for and about individuals in a health and social care setting.

- Promote health and safety practice in a health and social care setting.
- Promoting choice, well-being and the protection of all individuals in a health and social care setting.

Key Skills

Key Skills are a range of essential skills that are critical to succeed in the workplace today. There are two Key Skill areas (Communications and Application of Number) which participants complete through a combination of work-based assessments and a final test.

Mandatory Units

- Application of Number (Level 2)
- Communication (Level 2)

Key Skills will be completed during the assessor visits.

The recommended time to complete the Advanced Apprenticeship framework is 18 months.
