

Foundation Modern Apprenticeship in Children's Care Learning and Development Level 2

This qualification is aimed at individuals working within children's care, learning and development roles in: nursery day care, creches, schools, pre-schools/playgroups, children's centres, extended schools, hospitals or community based services.

Nearly all Level 2 roles are for those who are working under supervision in face-to-face roles with children and families.

On completion of the framework, the candidate will receive the following qualifications:

- City & Guilds Certificate in Children's Care Learning and Development Level 2
- Foundation Modern Apprenticeship in Children's Care Learning and Development
- Essential Skills Wales - Application of Number Level 1 and Communication Level 1

Mandatory Units (6)

Course Delivery:

An Assessor will visit the candidate at their workplace at least once a month for a minimum of one hour. In addition to this, a further 4 hours worth of work will need to be completed before the next assessment.
