

## Modern Apprenticeship in Children's Care Learning and Development Level 3

This qualification is aimed at individuals working independently or in some areas, supervising and training others in their field of work. These could include: creche leader, nursery supervisor, playgroup/pre-school leader, family support worker, health care support worker, supervisory role in an integrated centre or special needs support worker.

On completion of the framework, the candidate will receive the following qualifications:

- NVQ in Children's Care Learning and Development Level 3
- City & Guilds Certificate in Children's Care Learning and Development Level 3
- Modern Apprenticeship in Children's Care Learning and Development
- Key Skills - Application of Number Level 2 and Communication Level 2

## Level 3 National Vocational Qualification in Children's Care Learning and Development

It would not be possible for candidates who do not have some responsibility for children or access to children's provision to obtain the mandatory units of the NVQ at Level 3. Where Level 3 candidates have a peripatetic advisory role without direct responsibility for children, careful consideration, planning and guidance would be required to determine whether it would be possible to evidence competence for all the mandatory units.

### course details

#### Mandatory Units (5)

- Develop and promote positive relationships
- Develop and maintain a healthy, safe and secure environment for children
- Promote children's development
- Reflect on and develop practice
- Protect and promote children's rights

#### Optional Units (4)

- TWO must come from option group 1
- Plus a further TWO from either group 1 or group 2

### Course Delivery:

An Assessor will visit the candidate at their workplace at least once a month for a minimum of one hour. In addition to this, a further 4 hours worth of work will need to be completed before the next assessment.
